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Introducing Our 10-Week After-School Activities Program

Why the 10-Week Block Structure?

The shorter, focused duration of our blocks promotes better engagement and allows students to balance their interests with academic commitments. This format also provides the opportunity to explore a variety of activities over the course of the year

Key Features of the Program

- Limited Spaces for Enhanced Learning: Each course has a defined capacity to ensure an optimal environment for all participants. Spaces are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 10-Week Commitment: Registrations are now made per 10-week block, allowing parents and students to evaluate their participation on a more manageable timeline.
- Mid-Block Entry: Students may join mid-block if spaces are available, ensuring flexibility while maintaining group continuity.

Expert-Led Activities

All activities will be coached and taught by professionals who specialize in their respective fields. Each course is conducted by trusted external companies, carefully selected by Four-Forest to ensure the highest quality instruction and enriching experiences for our students.

Cancellations and Refunds

Important Information

Club Minimum Participation Requirements

All clubs listed above (excluding football) require a minimum of 5 participants to run. Football requires a minimum of 10 participants to run effectively and provide proper training. If the minimum number of students is not met, the club will not run during the 10-week allocated block.

Club Rotation During the School Year

Successful clubs with significant interest will be incorporated into Block C. For example, karate offered during Block B for Dinos/KG2 students will shift to G1/G2 students in Block C.

If significant interest is expressed in an ASC it is possible to add a second class. However, please keep in mind that lessons would be back-to-back. For example:

Tuesday Karate Dinos & KG2 15:15 - 16:15 & G1 & G2 16:15 - 17:15

Trials

The starting week of activities will serve as a trial period. No additional trials will be held during the 10-week block. However, students are welcome to join clubs during the 10-week period if space is available.

Parent Pick-Up Information

If your child is signed up for an ASC activity, please ensure you arrive on time for pick-up. If you anticipate being late, please call ahead. If your child is not picked up on time after their club ends, they will be sent to ASC care, where additional charges will apply. The school closes at **18:00 PM**, so it is essential that all parents arrive before **17:50 PM**.

If Your Child Is Signed Up for Both an ASC Activity and ASC Care

If you require additional care for your child after their activity concludes, please ensure they are registered for ASC care until 18:00 PM. If not, they will be added to a casual attendance list, and fees will be incurred every 15 minutes. **For clarification:** If your child is signed up for ASC care until 18:00 PM but is participating in a club that ends at 16:30, you will only be billed from 16:30 onwards for ASC care.
