This holistic approach to education ensures that students are well-prepared for future challenges both academically and personally.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Extracurricular Activities Programme

We are excited to announce a new structure for our extracurricular activities programme, designed to optimize participation and learning capabilities. Activities will now run in 12-week blocks, allowing students to fully immerse themselves in their chosen courses while offering flexibility to explore new interests throughout the year.

Why the 12-Week Block Structure?

The shorter, focused duration of our blocks promotes better engagement and allows students to balance their interests with academic commitments. This format also provides the opportunity to explore a variety of activities over the course of the year

Key Features of the Programme

- Limited Spaces for Enhanced Learning: Each course has a defined capacity to ensure an optimal environment for all participants. Spaces are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 12-Week Commitment: Registrations are now made per 12-week block, allowing parents and students to evaluate their participation on a more manageable timeline.
- Mid-Block Entry: Students may join mid-block if spaces are available, ensuring flexibility while maintaining group continuity.

Expert-Led Activities

All activities will be coached and taught by professionals who specialize in their respective fields. Each course is conducted by trusted external companies, carefully selected by Four-Forest to ensure the highest quality instruction and enriching experiences for our students.

Cancellations and Refunds

As we are running the programme in 12-week blocks, cancellations will not be necessary to submit. Before the end of the 12-week block, a new schedule will be sent out for you to sign-up for. However, if you wish to cancel during the 12-week block please get in touch with us via email. Refunds are not applicable for absences or withdrawals made after the block begins.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Club Minimum Participation Requirements

All clubs listed require a minimum of either 4 to 6 participants to run. If the minimum number of students is not met, the club will not run during the 12-week allocated block.

Additional Clubs

If significant interest is expressed in a ECS it may be possible to add a second class. However, please keep in mind that lessons would be back-to-back.

Trials

The starting week of activities will serve as a trial period. No additional trials for Block A will be held during the 12-weeks.

Parent Pick-Up Information

If your child is signed up for an Extracurricular activity, please ensure you arrive on time for pick-up. If you anticipate being late, please call ahead. If your child is not picked up on time after their club ends, they will be sent to ASC care, where additional charges will apply. The school closes at 18:00 PM, so it is essential that all parents arrive before then.

If Your Child Is Signed Up for Both an ECA Activity and ASC Care

If you require additional care for your child before or after their activity, please ensure they are registered for ASC care. If not, they will be added to a casual attendance list, and fees will be incurred. For clarification: If your child is signed up for ASC care until 18:00 PM but is participating in a club that ends at 16:30, you will only be billed from 16:30 onwards for ASC care.

The Play Sport Programme refines the more demanding ball skills for sports that are covered in schools and clubs.



Trimester 1

21 Aug - 27 Nov

Block 1 focuses on **BASKETBALL** and **BASEBALL**, introducing key skills like dribbling, throwing, catching, and batting. Fun games and simple activities help build coordination, teamwork, and confidence on the court and field.

In Block 2, children will discover **HANDBALL** and **HOCKEY**. Sessions will focus on passing, shooting, and moving with the ball, while learning the basics of team play, attack, and defence in fast-paced, engaging games.

Block 3 brings **TENNIS** and **VOLLEYBALL**, developing hand-eye coordination, rallying, serving, and basic court positioning. Fun drills and minigames encourage teamwork and active movement in a supportive environment.

The main emphasis of this programme is:

- Development of skills needed in a game situation
- The refinement of when, where and how to move in the execution of a skill
- The continued development of skills relating to "direction, distance and positioning"
- Introduction to teamwork and continued development of partner work
- Development of decision making in a game situation
- Playing small-sided sports games
